Your WILL enables you to provide for family members who you love

If you die without a Will your estate is distributed according to rules which may not be what you have wished and which may also result in more tax being paid.

If you marry or enter into a registered civil partnership this will automatically revoke your pre-existing Will. You need a new Will.

It is sensible to appoint an experienced solicitor/Will writer to prepare your Will and witness the signing of it. Homemade Wills are much more susceptible to challenge because there is no independent evidence to support the circumstances in which they were made and what the intentions of the testator were. They are often ambiguous and lead to family disputes and often do not fully use inheritance tax allowances.

We have quite generous inheritance tax allowances. A legal professional will know how to make sure that these are fully used and can also make sure that the Will is executed in compliance with the legal formalities which, if not handled properly will result in the Will being declared invalid.

It is commonly believed that we have complete freedom to write our Wills as we

wish. This is substantially true but the Inheritance (Provision for Family and Dependants) Act 1975 enables a family member or a dependant or cohabitee to make a claim in certain circumstances if they have not been provided for. Legal advice is essential in such circumstances.

Choosing the executors of your Will:

The Executors have many legal responsibilities and are personally liable if they incorrectly administer your estate. You should choose executors who are competent to perform their role, who are interested in doing so and who can work together.

It is vital to register Lasting Powers of Attorney (LPA) even many years ahead of any need arising.

Should you suffer incapacity even a joint bank account is frozen but your LPA attorneys who you have chosen to act for you will be able to administer your affairs. If you do not have LPAs in place your family will have to apply to Court for the appointment of a Deputy. This is a long and expensive process and the Court may chose to appoint a professional Deputy and this will result in professional fees. It is much better to have LPAs in place now.

FEBRUARY

February is the Rumpelstiltskin of months – short and bad-tempered – and it's hardly surprising if some of that gloom rubs off on us too. It's a bit difficult not to feel grumpy when it's cold, wet and grey outside.

It's in February, above all other months, that you might be forgiven for not sticking to your seasonal principles. There's only so much swede anyone can take, turkey has long since lost its appeal and even the sprouts are running out. But before you fall off the seasonal vegetable wagon, take a look at what else is on offer this month.

If ever there was a month designed for comfort food, this is it. Hearty stews and ragouts, together with the last of the feathered game, will keep us nourished and although it's true that sweet treats are thin on the ground, forced rhubarb continues to provide plenty of fruity goodness. That superstar of late winter, purple sprouting broccoli, usually hits the shelves this month, while hardy brassicas, onions and carrots are still plentiful, meaning that even if the choice isn't as broad as we might like, there's still plenty of good vegetables to go around.

Fun facts about Pancake Day and why we go flippin' crazy for Shrove Tuesday

- 1. The idea of eating pancakes on Shrove Tuesday is more than 1,000 years old! They were originally invented as a way of using up all the leftover fatty and rich foods before Lent begins on Ash Wednesday.
- 2. The largest pancake ever made measured 15 metres and weighed in at three tonnes you'll need a lot of sugar and lemon for that one.
- **3.** The most flips anyone has ever done with a pancake is 349 flips in two minutes. That's 'flipping' good!
- **4.** Over a lifetime, an average person will eat 7,300 eggs. In the UK, 52 million eggs are eaten on Pancake Day, which is 22 million more than on any other day of the year!
- **5.** In France, people like to make a wish before flipping their pancakes. They do this while holding a coin in the other hand.
- **6.** On average we consume two pancakes per person on Pancake Day, which means that we get through 117 million pancakes in one

- day! This requires enough milk to fill more than 93 Olympic swimming pools and almost 13 million kilos of plain flour.
- 7. We all have our preferences for pancake toppings but the weirdest pancake toppings have to be sour cream and caviar, ketchup and mustard, peanut butter and ice cream, coco pops and cream, cream cheese and strawberries.
- **8.** Andrei Smirnov from Russia ate a colossal 73 pancakes in one hour! That's more than one a minute.
- 9. The Guinness World Record for the most pancakes served in eight hours is 34 818

- **10.** Before baking soda was invented, cooks often used fresh snow as it contained ammonia, which helped the pancakes come out fluffy and soft.
- **11.** It isn't just us William Shakespeare was a pancake lover! It is reflected in many of his plays.
- **12.** The highest pancake toss reached 329cm high. Good luck trying to beat that!
- **13.** In France and the United States Pancake day is called Mardi Gras which means 'Fat' or 'Grease Tuesday'

YOUR **HEALTH** MATTERS

Be kind to yourself!

February, for a Sports Therapist, Biomechanics Coach and Rehab therapist, is a very busy month. Why? People get injured, mainly from overdoing it. We call it a "too much, too soon injury".

When you see a 30-day Challenge being promoted somewhere, the person who came up with it has no idea what baseline you are starting from. Even Couch to 5k can be too much for some people.

As a rule of thumb, tissue should not be overloaded by more than 10% from the previous week, but experience would suggest it should be even less as it is better to err on the side of caution.

Type 'Ab Challenge' into the internet and work out the increase in the load from Day 1 to Day 30. I guarantee you it is more than 40% from Day 1 to Day 30. A LOT more. And hence the chances of getting injured raise exponentially.

An elite sports person may be looking at a week on week improvement of 0.1% across their various stats/goals. This is enough to keep them improving and not plateauing without getting injured.

So, as an untrained individual why would you be looking for 10 to 20% per week improvements?



It is obviously too much, too soon.

Let's take lifting weights.

If you go into a gym to do bench presses, it could look like this:

Week 1 - Bench 3 sets of 10 reps of 20kg = 600kg.

Week 2 - (Well that was easy, so let's increase) 4 sets of 12 reps of 25kg = 1200kg. (that's 100% increase)

Week 3 - (It still felt a bit easy, so you push harder) 5 sets of 15 reps of 30kg = 2250kg. (that's a further 90% increase)

Week 4 - You may not have actually found your level yet, so you bring in 3 sets of chest flys at 10kg Dumbbells for 10 reps plus 3 sets on top of Bench Press = 2850kg.

In 4 weeks, the load has increased by over 400%! Now can you see why you get injuries?

As Beginners of anything we can sometimes be too enthusiastic, and this is where a Sports Performance Coach comes in. So please take it easy, be kind to yourselves and take advice where applicable. If you are injured then look us up and if you don't want to get injured, look us up. It's what we do.



Leap Year Superstitions...

Our everyday calendar has been juggled with through the centuries in an effort to make it more accurate and more useful. The time it takes for the earth to rotate the sun is 365 ¼ days but the calendar year is 365 days, hence once every four years to balance this, we have a leap year and an extra day, February 29th.

Because such years are rarer than normal years, they have become lucky omens. For example, February 29th in the leap year of 1504 was very successful for Christopher Columbus.

The famous explorer had been marooned for several months on the small island of Jamaica. Though the island natives had initially offered food and provisions, Columbus' rather overbearing attitude had so annoyed the natives that they stopped this altogether.

Facing starvation, Columbus came up with an inspired plan. Consulting a shipboard almanac and finding that a lunar eclipse was due, he called together the native chiefs and announced to them that God would punish them if they did not supply his crew with food. And as an omen of God's intent to punish them, there would be a sign in the sky: God would darken the Moon.

Right on cue, the lunar eclipse started. Columbus dramatically disappeared into his cabin as the natives began to panic and begged him to restore the Moon. After more than an hour, Columbus emerged from his cabin and announced that God was prepared to withdraw his punishment if the natives agreed to supply him and his crew with everything they needed. The native chiefs immediately agreed, and



within minutes the Moon started emerging from shadow, leaving the natives in awe of Columbus' power. Columbus continued to receive food and supplies until he was rescued in June 1504.

For women, February 29th can also be a very successful day, as once every four years on the 29th February they have the "right" to propose to a man.

The right of every women to propose on 29th February each leap year goes back hundreds of years when the leap year day had no recognition in English law (the day was 'leapt over' and ignored, hence the term 'leap year'). It was decided that the day had no legal status, meaning that a break in tradition on this day was acceptable.

So on this day, women can take advantage of this anomaly and propose to the man they wish to marry.

In Scotland however, to ensure success they should also wear a red petticoat under their dress – and make sure that it is partly visible to the man when they propose.

For those wishing to take advantage of this ancient tradition, 29th February is your day!

How do you bring an imaginary setting to life in a reader's mind? Local author, Susan Sachon, used first-hand experience. Her debut thriller is set in a Tudor pub, in the village of Wethershall-End. The Garden Diary

Houseplant Heaven

As we wait indoors out of the cold, looking closely for signs of life re-emerging outside, houseplants can play a role in making our lives altogether healthier and happier. These suggestions might be somewhere to start, but be warned! It's hard to stop at just one plant (and also be aware that some houseplants are toxic, so if you have pets or children you should always check before purchasing).

Zamioculcas zamiifolia

This upright, fern-like plant has been available for several years, and remains popular because it is comparatively easy to grow and enjoys a wide



range of conditions (except prolonged direct sunlight). For something a bit different, watch out for the near-black variety called 'Raven' or 'Dowon'. The juvenile growth starts lime green before turning almost black as it matures.

Aglaonema

If you're looking to make a statement with dramatic foliage, then the Aglaonema family (Chinese evergreen) will have what you need. From the virtually white leaves of 'White Joy', the pink painted 'Crete' or the bold stripes of 'Tigress' there is an aglaonema for every home! Just be mindful that the lighter the leaf colour the more light they require (although still protected from direct sunlight).

Streptocarpus or African violet (formerly Saintpaulia)

Recently reclassified under the Streptocarpus genus, African violets have been around since the 1890s. But as flowering houseplants become more fashionable, this classic is making a comeback. 'Barbie' has lightly frilled flowers with a purple-white gradient, while 'Southern Night' has intense dark blue flowers with white-edged foliage.

Hoya gracilis

Commonly called the wax plant, this climber is most often used in hanging baskets. With a little early or late direct sunlight, it produces small but highly scented flowers, but will need to be kept out of drafts and misted to prevent the leaves drying out (especially if the heating is on).

Ficus lyrata

If you're looking for something with real presence, then you should definitely consider the fiddle leaf fig. With its large glossy foliage it will reach over a metre tall, so is one for the floor, but its tropical appearance will ensure that it's a fabulous addition to a draught-free room with indirect light. Water sparingly as they can suffer from rot, and wipe the leaves, while misting will

help prevent the foliage drying out.

See you back here in March - when Spring arrives!



MP Musings

Alistair Strathern, Member of Parliament for Mid Bedfordshire

As a man with a great fondness and enthusiasm for Irn-Bru and a habit of throwing my body on the line on the football pitch, it is fair to say that over the years I have had to rely quite a few times on fantastic NHS dental care. But, as I know is the case for residents across Mid Bedfordshire, those positive past experiences of NHS dentistry are exactly that—a thing of the past.

My inbox is inundated with heart-breaking stories from residents, who are unable to find an NHS dentist and unable to afford a private one. Just in the last few weeks, I have had constituents contacting me to express their frustration and challenge in accessing routine dental appointments, with NHS dentists telling them they can only provide emergency care.

It beggars' belief that people are forced to wait for things to get worse just so they can afford to be seen. And tragically, they're far from alone.

Last year nearly 800 people across
Bedfordshire were admitted to accident and
emergency units for tooth-related reasons.
In the year before, 165 children in central
Bedfordshire presented at hospitals requiring
a tooth extraction. That's 165 young people
who had to go to hospital to receive treatment
for conditions that should have been picked
up months earlier.

NHS dentistry must be accessible for all, and I made this point in Parliament this month.

For years dentists have been sounding the alarm about the rot in dental care, but rather than working with professionals to bring about the changes that are needed, the Government has ignored them, rolling out only minor tweaks, which has allowed the crisis to worsen.

We are nearly a year on from the promise of a dental recovery plan which is yet to be published, but our NHS dentists need immediate support to alleviate the pressures they are facing and the pain their patients are suffering.

I'm proud a Labour government would prioritise dentistry, recruiting dentists in areas with the greatest need, delivering 700,000 more urgent appointments for patients, and reforming the NHS dentistry contract to get the service back on track.

Labour are determined to tackle the root of these problems and we will ensure dentists are there for people across Mid Bedfordshire when they need them.

But people shouldn't have to wait for an election to see things improve, so I'll be campaigning on this issue locally for as long as Rishi Sunak puts off calling an election.



Last summer Ampthill dad of three, Dave Bateson raised more than £24k for Addenbrooke's Charitable Trust after arranging a sell-out charity football game.

Now Dave, 48, who has lived in Ampthill for more than a decade, wants to raise even more for Addenbrooke's because this hospital has helped him successfully live with stage four cancer.

In 2019, Dave was diagnosed with melanoma. It has since spread to his spine, liver and lungs. But after receiving a course of immunotherapy at Addenbrooke Hospital, his cancer has now stabilised. Dave decided he wanted to give something back by raising as much as he could to help build a new hospital and help fund more research into new treatments.

Last July Dave organised a pre-season friendly between Ampthill Town and Luton Town Under 21's. He was blown away by the incredible support shown by the local community. On Saturday 2nd March, he is organising a party in Luton. An auction and raffle will also be held and all proceeds will be donated once again to Addenbrooke's Charitable Trust.

Dave explains: "I am proof that thanks to the incredible treatment, you can live with cancer and I want to try and raise more to help the continued research and new drugs needed to fight the disease. I was told that ten years ago I wouldn't be here today. It's all down to the incredible new treatment I have received."




